TITLE:
Introduction of an Ordinance to Adopt the City Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2009, Through June 30, 2010, and Levying an Ad Valorem Tax on all Assessable Property Within the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland

SUPPORTING BACKGROUND:
An ordinance to adopt the Fiscal Year 2009 – 2010 City Budget was advertised in the April 15, 2009, issue of the Gaithersburg Gazette.
This ordinance establishes the City Budget, which provides a complete financial plan, including anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010. The ordinance also institutes the ad valorem tax on all assessable property within the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland. The ad valorem tax has been set at a rate of \$.212 on each \$100 of assessed value of real property and \$.53 on each \$100 of assessed value of Personal Property.
In order to make real property tax bills simpler and easier to understand, the General Assembly, under Chapter 80 of the Acts of 2000, has required that property tax rates on real property be based on a full (100%) cash value assessment.
The Budget Public Hearing will be held May 4, 2009. Anticipated budget work sessions will be held on May 5, 2009, May 7, 2009, and if necessary, May 11, 2009 at the City Hall Council Chambers.

ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY BUDGET
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2009, THROUGH
JUNE 30, 2010, AND LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX ON
ALL ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF
GAITHERSBURG, MARYLAND

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the 2009-10 Fiscal Year was submitted by the City Manager to the Mayor and City Council as required by the City Charter, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the 2009-10 budget provides a complete financial plan, including anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures, for the fiscal year:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gaithersburg, in public meeting assembled, that the budget for the City of Gaithersburg for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, be and it hereby is adopted as follows:

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all of the sums set forth herein under the heading "PROPOSED EXPENDITURES" be and hereby are appropriated.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that there is hereby levied on all of the assessable real property within the City an ad valorem tax at the rate of *Twenty-one and Two/Tenths Cents (\$.212) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed value of said property*, and there is hereby levied an ad valorem tax on the tangible personal property subject to taxation by the City, except for manufacturing equipment, manufacturing inventory and commercial inventory of corporate and unincorporated businesses, at the rate of Fifty-Three Cents (\$.53) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed value of such tangible personal property.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City hereby adopts the imposition of a full year, one-half year, three-quarter year and one-quarter year tax levies authorized pursuant to Title 10, Sections 10-102, 10-103, 10-104 and 10-105, Tax Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, and authorizes and empowers Montgomery County, Maryland, to collect and remit the same to the City of Gaithersburg, consistent with the imposition and collection of such levies on real property by Montgomery County.
