## Crime Analysis Report 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2011

There has been a **4.6% decrease** in crime within the City of Gaithersburg for the second quarter of 2011, as compared to the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) statistics for the second quarter of 2010:

Part I Crime <b>decreased by 4.8%</b>	(from 478 to 455)
Part II Crime <b>decreased by 4.5%</b>	(from 988 to 944)
Overall, Total Crime (Part I and Part II totals) <b>decreased by 4.6%</b>	

Homicide:	Not calculable	(from 0 to 1)
Rape:	50.0% decrease	(from 2 to 1)
Robbery:	7.7% decrease	(from 13 to 12)
Aggravated Assault:	14.3% increase	(from 14 to 16)
Burglary:	6.5% increase	(from 46 to 49)
Larceny:	8.3% decrease	(from 385 to 353)
Auto Theft:	27.8% increase	(from 18 to 23)

An analysis of Part I Offense data shows that there was an increase this quarter (as compared to the same quarter in 2010) in homicides, aggravated assaults, burglaries and auto thefts. There was a decrease in rapes, robberies and larcenies.

An analysis of the data between the first quarter of 2011, which had a 20.7% decrease as compared to the fourth quarter of 2010, and the second quarter of 2011 shows an overall **increase in crime of 19.8%**. Part I Offenses increased by 16.4% (from 391 to 455) with the following categories showing increases - homicides (from 0 to 1), robberies up 9.1% (from 11 to 12), aggravated assaults up 45.5% (from 11 to 16), burglaries up 28.9% (from 38 to 49), larcenies up 13.9% (from 310 to 353) and auto thefts up 35.3% (from 17 to 23). Part II Offenses increased by 21.5% (from 777 to 944).

Part II Crimes are defined as minor assaults, arson, forgery-counterfeiting, bad checks, embezzlement, stolen property, vandalism, weapons offenses, prostitution, sex offenses, controlled dangerous substance (CDS) violations, gambling, family offenses, juvenile offenses, liquor law violations, disorderly conduct, suicide, and non-traffic offenses.

### Cumulative Year to Date

There has been an **8.0% decrease** in crime within the City of Gaithersburg for January-June of 2011, as compared to the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) statistics for January-June of 2010:

Part I Crime <b>decreased by 12.1%</b>		(from 962 to 846)
Part II Crime <b>decreased by 5.8%</b>		(from 1,827 to 1,721)
Overall, Total Crime (Part I and Part II totals) <b>decreased by 8.0%</b>

Rape:	No change	(from 5 to 5)
Robbery:	25.8% decrease	(from 31 to 23)

Auto Theft:	2.4% decrease	(from 41 to 40)
