Crime Analysis Report 3rd Quarter 2016

For Release: 10/24/2016

There has been a **10.5% decrease** in crime within the City of Gaithersburg for the third quarter of 2016¹, as compared to the statistics for the third quarter of 2015¹:

- Part I Crime **decreased by 11.2%** (from 492 to 437)
- Part II Crime² **decreased by 9.9%** (from 568 to 512)
- Overall, Total Crime (Part I and Part II totals) **decreased by 10.5%**

Homicide:	No change	(from 0 to 0)
Rape:	25.0% increase	(from 4 to 5)
Robbery:	137.5% increase	(from 8 to 19)
Aggravated Assault:	11.8% increase	(from 17 to 19)
Burglary:	48.1% decrease	(from 52 to 27)
Larceny:	10.2% decrease	(from 383 to 344)
Auto Theft:	17.9% decrease	(from 28 to 23)

Cumulative Year to Date

There has been a **4.2% decrease** in crime within the City of Gaithersburg for January-September of 2016¹, as compared to the statistics for January-September of 2015¹:

- Part I Crime **decreased by 5.8%** (from 1,277 to 1,203)
- Part II Crime² **decreased by 2.9%** (from 1,536 to 1,491)
- Overall, Total Crime (Part I and Part II totals) **decreased by 4.2%**

Homicide:	100.0% increase	(from 1 to 2)
Rape:	35.7% increase	(from 14 to 19)
Robbery:	17.6% increase	(from 34 to 40)
Aggravated Assault:	38.4% decrease	(from 73 to 45)
Burglary:	35.0% decrease	(from 123 to 80)
Larceny:	0.4% decrease	(from 981 to 977)
Auto Theft:	21.6% decrease	(from 51 to 40)

¹ Crime statistics from the Montgomery County Records Management System as of October 11, 2016. As this system is live data may fluctuate from day to day. Unfounded incidents are not included. The reporting structure for Part II Crimes has been modified.

²Part II Crimes are defined as minor assaults, arson, forgery-counterfeiting, bad checks, embezzlement, stolen property, vandalism, weapons offenses, prostitution, sex offenses, controlled dangerous substance (CDS) violations, gambling, family offenses, juvenile offenses, liquor law violations, disorderly conduct, suicide, and non-traffic offenses.
