Chapter 24, Article 9, Section 24-9.4(J)

Administrative approvals – appeals. For all administrative approvals, the decision of the planning director or designee may be appealed to the city historic district commission if filed with the planning department, in writing, within fifteen (15) days after the decision is mailed by the planning director. The historic district commission, in its discretion, may hold a public review on the decision of the planning director, or order written statements and oral argument in lieu of a public review. The historic district commission may approve, approve with modification, or disapprove the requested amendment(s) and shall state the reasons for its action in writing.
