SUBJECT: CTAM-8364-2019 - Sign Ordinance

At its regular meeting on March 18, 2020, the Planning Commission discussed the two options for temporary signs in the right of way presented by staff. The Commission noted that Option B, which bases the allowable sign size on the type of adjacent road, introduces a level of complexity and potential conflict that is absent in the simpler Option A, which establishes the same standards for all temporary signs in the right of way. The Commission felt that Option A was the better choice for handling temporary signs in the right of way. The Commission also discussed the proposed clarification language in the revised draft ordinances posted on the City's web site, as well as the additional clarification language introduced at the meeting, and indicated their support for all of the proposed clarification language. At the conclusion of its review during the March 18, 2020 meeting, the Planning Commission made the following motion:
